Router Quick Start




1. Use the supplied grey cable to connect from the dsl port, into the splitter, and the splitter — into the wall. (If you have a square port in the wall, then the splitter may not be



needed)

Your router will arrive preconfigured.

All you will need to do is plug in as below and wait a
few minutes once it has logged in.



2. Ports 1-4 are your standard network ports to connect devices.

Connect the supplied power cable here.

Don't forget the router will receive it's configuration once it has come online for the first time. This will cause the router to restart and should be ready in around 6 minutes.
